BACKGROUND

Council resolved at its ordinary meeting held 21st June 2011 to initiate the statutory review process of its local laws, in accordance with Section 3.16 of the Local Government Act 1995. Mr Murray Brown (former local government CEO) had been engaged to assist with the preliminary work associated with this task. As noted in the previous report to Council, Mr Brown advised that the Shire of Leonora's local laws were examined and found to be of a high standard.

As noted in the previous report to Council, current local laws and the date they were published in the Government Gazette are set out hereunder:

General Provisions Local Law

Health Local Laws

Local Law Leonora Airport 8th January, 2001 (Amendment 23rd November, 2001)

Public notice, as required by Section 3.16(2) and 3.16(2)(a) was published in the Kalgoorlie Miner on 25th June 2011. No submissions were received following the cut off date, which was six weeks from the date of publication of the review.

To finalise the statutory review required by Section 3.16 of the Act, Section 3.12(3) and (4) provide that after the last day for submissions, the local government is to consider any submissions made and cause a report of the review to be prepared and submitted to its Council.

When the Council has considered the report, the local government may determine by an absolute majority whether or not it considers that a local law should be repealed or amended.

As mentioned above, the current local laws are considered to be of a high standard, and therefore no amendments are considered necessary.

STATUTORY ENVIRONMENT

Section 3.16 of the Local Government Act 1995 states that local laws must be reviewed within a period of eight years.

To finalise the statutory review required by Section 3.16 of the Act, Section 3.12(3) and (4) provide that after the last day for submissions, the local government is to consider any submissions made and cause a report of the review to be prepared and submitted to its Council. When the Council has considered the report, the local government may determine by an absolute majority whether or not it considers that a local law should be repealed or amended.

POLICY IMPLICATIONS

There are no policy implications resulting from the adoption of this report.

FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

A budget provision of \$20,000 has been included in the 2011/12 budget for consultancy type expenses. Fees to be paid for this service will come to approximately \$1,383.05.

STRATEGIC IMPLICATIONS

The Local Government Act 1995 enables Western Australian local governments to make local laws considered necessary for the good government of their districts. Laws can only be made when authorised by the Local Government Act 1995 or other written laws but cannot be inconsistent with any State or Federal law.

- 34. Financial activity statement report s. 6.4
 - (1A) In this regulation —

committed assets means revenue unspent but set aside under the annual budget for a specific purpose.

- 34. (1) A local government is to prepare each month a statement of financial activity reporting on the revenue and expenditure, as set out in the annual budget under regulation 22(1)(d), for that month in the following detail—
 - (a) annual budget estimates, taking into account any expenditure incurred for an additional purpose under section 6.8(1)(b) or (c);
 - (b) budget estimates to the end of the month to which the statement relates;
 - (c) actual amounts of expenditure, revenue and income to the end of the month to which the statement relates;

- (d) material variances between the comparable amounts referred to in paragraphs (b) and (c); and
- (e) the net current assets at the end of the month to which the statement relates.
- 34. (2) Each statement of financial activity is to be accompanied by documents containing
 - (a) an explanation of the composition of the net current assets of the month to which the statement relates, less committed assets and restricted assets;
 - (b) an explanation of each of the material variances referred to in subregulation (1)(d); and
 - (c) such other supporting information as is considered relevant by the local government.
- 34. (3) The information in a statement of financial activity may be shown
 - (a) according to nature and type classification; or
 - (b) by program; or
 - (c) by business unit.
- 34. (4) A statement of financial activity, and the accompanying documents referred to in subregulation (2), are to be
 - (a) presented at an ordinary meeting of the council within 2 months after the end of the month to which the statement relates; and
 - (b) recorded in the minutes of the meeting at which it is presented.
- 34. (5) Each financial year, a local government is to adopt a percentage or value, calculated in accordance with the AAS, to be used in statements of financial activity for reporting material variances.
