## BACKGROUND

As you are aware Mr David Fitzgerald, Mr David Wilcox and Mr Cyril Linto volunteered their time to investigate, study and report on the spread of various types of Cactus within the Leonora townsite, in particular Gwalia and the surrounding areas. Their commitment to this project demonstrates how passionate and concerned they are about the existence of certain types of cactus and the likelihood of new areas in the region becoming infested if immediate action is not taken to eradicate the "weed".

As you know, Mr David Fitzgerald is a former pastoralist in the Region having owned the Nambi pastoral property for decades. Mr David Wilcox is a former Head of the Rangeland Branch of the Department of Agriculture and Mr Cyril Linto was a form Stock and Weeds Inspector with the Department of Agriculture.

Their report titled "The Spread of Cactus in the Leonora Area, WA" clearly demonstrates that the Rose Cactus is an emerging problem in the Region. It is considered a serious environmental weed in Queensland and in South Australia and is rigorously controlled in those states.

The report compiled by Messrs Fitzgerald, Wilcox and Linto was posted to all Council members on the 28<sup>th</sup> August, 2008. All recommendations suggested in the report should be considered seriously.

I am in favour of submitting the Report as an Agenda item at a future Goldfields Esperance Country Zone meeting of the Western Australian Local Government Association not only to raise awareness of the problem but to gather full support from within the whole Region so that we or the Association can tackle the Government head on in regards immediate action.

## BACKGROUND

The Shire of Leonora operates a security regulated airport pursuant to section 28 of the Aviation Transport Security Act 2004.

For this reason and pursuant to section 12 of the Aviation Transport Security Act 2004, the Shire of Leonora is required to have an approved Transport Security Program ('TSP') for Leonora Airport. The Leonora Airport TSP was approved by the Secretary of the then Department of Transport and Regional Services on the 10<sup>th</sup> March, 2005.

Section 14 of the Aviation Transport Security Act 2004 provides that an aviation industry participant commits an offence if there is a TSP for the participant in force and the participant fails to comply with the program. Furthermore, a TSP may be cancelled in circumstances where the participant fails to comply with its TSP (s.26). A participant must have a TSP in force in order to operate (s.13).

The Leonora Airport TSP sets out certain requirements relating to audit and review of the Transport Security Program in section 5.2 of the TSP. These provisions require the TSP to be audited on an annual basis.

Note that regulation 2.01(2)(a) of the Aviation Transport Security Regulations 2005 defines an audit as a reference to an examination by an aviation industry participant of security measures under the participant's TSP to find out whether the measures have been implemented correctly.

The Shire of Leonora has requested Aviation Security Auditors (Australia) to undertake an audit to determine its compliance with the requirements of its TSP. The on-site phase of the audit was undertaken at the Leonora Airport on the 13<sup>th</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup> August, 2008. A separate document review has also been undertaken by Aviation Security Auditors (Australia) to ensure the TSP's compliance with the requirements of the Aviation Transport Security Regulations 2005.

This audit report presents the audit findings and the results of the document review.

The audit report is a "Security-In-Confidence" document and as a consequence does not form part of this report. The audit report was forwarded to all Members on the 29<sup>th</sup> August, 2008 for their perusal with a request that the information remain confidential.

### STATUTORY ENVIRONMENT

In accordance with the requirements of regulation 2.01(2)(a) of the Aviation Transport Security Regulations 2005, Aviation Transport Security Act 2004 and the Leonora Airport Transport Security Program.

## POLICY IMPLICATIONS

There are no policy implications resulting from the recommendations of this report.

## FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

An amount of \$10,000.00 is contained within the current budget to cover consultancy type services at the Leonora airport.

#### STRATEGIC IMPLICATIONS

Through measures, the Australian Government seeks to enhance protection of the aviation industry from terrorist and other security threats through an integrated approach across jurisdictions, between government agencies and with the aviation industry itself to ensure adequate prevention and preparedness. The objective is to ensure a nationally consistent protective security regime of physical measures and awareness that creates an environment hostile to terrorist activity, including for the identification and resolution of suspicious activity.
